Performance area will usually be in the school hall.

Persons at risk

Pupils, staff and performers.

Hazards

Set falling.

Tripping on power cable.

Contact.

We bring NO hazardous material or equipment into schools.

Controlling Measures

- Scenery, where possible, are made from wood and canvas so the whole set is very light and has no sharp edges.
- o Sets made with wood are erected within a set distance from the audience.
- o All power cables crossing an open area are taped down or covered during the performance.
- o Pupils will not come in contact with any props or equipment.
- o Actors will not arrive before the agreed time.
- Actors will contact the teacher or reception via telephone when they arrive so they
 can be greeted outside the building and informed which entrance they must use to
 set up.
- All performers will use 2 sets of protective gloves. The first set used during setting up for door handles, light switches etc. The second set used while packing away. These will then be disposed of.
- The edge of the performance area and the first row of students must be at least 3 meters apart.
- o No student should enter the performance area during the performance.

Onatti will regularly review these measures and will implement additional measures to comply with any individual school's policies.

A performance is classed by us as a low risk.

All set-up and dismantling of sets are done only by members of the company.

Pupils should be told **not** to approach or touch any equipment or scenery which Onatti Productions brings into the school.
